Being nominated for an award

Congratulations on being nominated for an award! The person nominating you thinks you deserve recognition for the difference you're making, and that your story could inspire others.

We have answered some questions you may have about being a nominee.

What is the process for being nominated?

Your nominator will complete an online form which tells us a bit about you, your contribution to lifelong learning, and the difference you have made to people's lives. The form will ask them to include a statement from yourself, telling us in your own words about the learning you have supported and/or delivered and the impact this has had.

Once the nomination form has been completed, your nominator will submit it to the Get the Nation Learning team. The final deadline for this is Friday 25 July 2025.

What do I need to write about in my statements?

The nomination form asks for a statement from you, the nominee.

This should provide an overview of your role, the learning you have supported and/or delivered, and the impact this has had on learners. It should also include information you're your commitment to professional development and the difference this has made to you and others. This should be a maximum of 250 words.

When will I know if I have won an award?

We will notify all award winners and their nominators in August 2025.

What happens if I win an award?

If you are selected as an award winner, someone from the Get the Nation Learning team will contact you in August to let you know. We will announce award winners publicly at our ceremony in central London on Tuesday 4 November 2025. All award winners will be invited to the ceremony.

Between August and November 2025, we will prepare your story to include in our communications, for example on the Get the Nation Learning website and/or in the media. We will not share any information about you without your permission.
