Overview

Nominations for the 2026 Get the Nation Learning Awards are now open. This pack provides you with all the information you need to promote the awards to your network and encourage people and organisations you know to nominate others or themselves and get involved.

What are the Get the Nation Learning Awards?

The Get the Nation Learning Awards are the biggest celebration of lifelong learning in England. They shine a light on people and organisations getting the nation learning, and examples of adult learning that support healthier futures, stronger communities, more opportunities, regional growth, and richer lives.

The awards form a core part of the Get the Nation Learning campaign. This aims to make and win the case for the importance of lifelong learning and provide a common platform to organisations having an impact in this area.

Who is eligible for the awards?

There are a wide range of categories with eligibility differing by award. However, across the board, we are looking for:

- Employers prioritising workplace training and learning and development within their organisation
- Community organisations breaking down barriers to learning and engaging people from all backgrounds
- Learning providers going the extra mile to maximise the impact of their provision on the lives of adults
- Local and regional governments placing adult education at the heart of their ambitions
- People who have experienced life changing benefits as a result of engaging in adult learning
